NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX INCREASE FOR THE MUNDELEIN PARK AND RECREATION DISTRICT

Also known as the MUNDELEIN PARK DISTRICT

- I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for the Mundelein Park and Recreation District for tax year 2020 will be held on December 14, 2020 at 6:45 p.m., virtually. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and state guidelines/restrictions, this meeting will be held virtually through Zoom. All are welcome, but for security reasons, the link to the meeting and password is available by emailing the Executive Director Ron Salski at rsalski@mundeleinparks.org or calling 847-388-5460.

- II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended for tax year 2019 were \$4,256,931. The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for tax year 2020 are \$4,374,837. This represents a 2.77% increase over the previous year.
- III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for tax year 2019 were \$506,320.

The estimate property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for tax year 2020 are \$519,292. This represents a 2.56% increase from the previous year.

- IV. The total property taxes extended for tax year 2019 were \$4,763,251.

The estimate total property taxes to be levied for tax year 2020 are \$4,894,129. This represents a 2.75% increase over the previous year.
