Rules for Public Comment:

- A. At the start of the period for public comment the board President or acting chairperson will advise the public:
 - 1. The amount of time permitted for public comment;
 - 2. That all speakers state their name and addresses before addressing the Board;
 - 3. To avoid repetitive comments, testimony and general questions; and
 - 4. To appoint only one person to speak on behalf of a group.
- B. Each person will be permitted to speak one time only, unless the President determines that allowing a speaker to address the Board again will contribute new testimony or evidence germane to an issue on the agenda for that meeting.
- C. Unless a representative spokesperson is appointed in the manner described in rule D, all comments from the public will be limited to no more than three (3) minutes per person.
- D. Groups may register a representative spokesperson by filing an appearance form no later than one (1) hour in advance of a meeting. The appearance form must designate (i) the number of people the designee represents for the purpose of making public comment; (ii) the subject matter of the public comments; and (iii) whether the subject begin represented by a group spokesperson shall be deemed to have waived their opportunity to speak independently unless the President determines that allowing such a speaker to address the Board will contribute new testimony or evidence germane to an issue on the agenda for that meeting.
 - 1. A representative spokesperson who timely files a complete appearance form to speak on a matter germane to the agenda shall be permitted to speak for three (3) minutes for each person being represented, up to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes.
 - 2. A representative spokesperson who timely files a complete appearance form to speak on a matter not germane to the agenda shall be permitted to speak for three (3) minutes for each person being represented, up to a maximum of nine (9) minutes.
- E. The Board shall not respond to questions posed during public comment. All questions shall be recorded by the Board Secretary and a response shall be presented either during the next regular Board meeting or in writing before such meeting.

January 10, 2022 Committee Meeting Topics

COVID-19

Staff will update the Board on various approaches and guidelines for participants and staff.

The Development at Oak Creek

Executive Director Salski and Attorney Simon presented a draft agreement to D.R. Horton and waiting for a response; however, both parties have agreed on the main details. D.R. Horton has been working diligently and hoping to finalize an agreement at the January 24, 2022 Regular Board meeting because the Village Board will not approve the project until a final agreement is reached between D.R. Horton and Mundelein Park and Recreation District.

The District did a due diligence on the creek by retaining Gewalt Hamilton. Executive Director Salski negotiated D.R. Horton reimburse the District for Gewalt Hamilton's consulting fees. Based upon Gewalt Hamilton's assessment, nothing of major concern was found for the understanding of a passive recreation and nature reserve park use. The flow of the inlet to the detention basin is likely inhibited as the pipe is nearly half submerged. Additionally, the erosion occurring leaving roots exposed is minor, there are no areas where there is risk of a large tree falling over/losing mass amounts of vegetation. It is worth noting the project area is within a flood zone and floodway and is shown to flood in a 100-year storm event, thus is likely to experience flooding.

MINUTES Mundelein Park & Recreation District Committee of the Whole December 13, 2021

The Committee of the Whole meeting of the Board of Park Commissioners of the Mundelein Park and Recreation District was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

President FRASIER directed the Secretary to call the roll. Present were Commissioners DOLAN McGRATH, ORTEGA and FRASIER. Commissioner KNUDSON was absent with prior notice.

Staff present included Executive Director SALSKI.

Executive Director SALSKI discussed the current vision, mission and values of the Park District and provided feedback. Commissioner ORTEGA suggested revising several words to incorporate "community." Commissioner DOLAN provided feedback on the vision statement wording to add, "for those we serve," because Steeple Chase has many non-residents. Executive Director SALSKI stated he will discuss with Commissioner ORTEGA and present revised language for the vision, mission and values.

Executive Director SALSKI presented the Emergency Crisis Management Plan and confirmed with Board Members the spokesperson is the Executive Director. Board Members agreed. Commissioner ORTEGA suggested redefining, "crisis." Commissioner DOLAN recommended removing employee names in the document and keep position titles only so Board doesn't need to approve revisions with any vacancies. Board Members agreed.

Executive Director SALSKI explained the current processes for the Museum. He started with Acquisition Policy and Procedure. Commissioner ORTEGA asked what items were considered loans. Mike Flynn clarified and mentioned there are three items: hose reel, rifle and lectern from church. Mike Flynn reiterated a donor fills out a Deed of Gift form which has language transferring the item(s) to the Mundelein Park and Recreation District.

Next, Executive Director SALSKI presented the Deaccession Policy and Procedures. He discussed the reasons for deaccessioning and the Historical Commission will revise its form for approval by the Park Board to include the reasons. He stated it will allow Board Members to better understand why item(s) were being deaccessioned. Commissioner DOLAN asked if the Museum adds new displays and how often. Mike Flynn stated the Museum is closed for the season and will change out key rooms. Mike Flynn explained all the items that were part of the original accession do not have Deed of Gift forms or names/phone numbers provided. Commissioner DOLAN explained his concerns for sensitivity whether a form was filled out or not. Mike Flynn agreed with being sensitive to past and current donors and provided recent examples of a wedding dress and plates. Executive Director SALSKI explained how the Mundelein Park and Recreation District will dispose of item(s) if a donor is unknown. He stated the district website will have information and Marketing Department will send out an eblast

asking if anyone may want the item(s) back. The District will hold for 45 days. For any item(s) with a donor name/address, Historical Commission will contact donor. Also, he stated specific items could go to a local Goodwill Store, be discarded and/or returned to archive. He mentioned some archival item(s) are documents and papers. He explained there are clothes that are ripped and/or disintegrated that may be discarded immediately after approval. Mike Flynn mentioned most original item(s) do not have donors names/phone numbers attached. Commissioner DOLAN agreed with all the procedures and felt it was important to make an effort due to the sensitivity. Mike Flynn stated a column would be added if the donor is known or unknown. Executive Director SALSKI mentioned the challenges with the current storage such as inaccessibility, current tenant needing more storage and inadequate size of space. Mike Flynn thanked the Board for addressing the processes. Board Members thanked Mike Flynn for his time and for attending the meeting to clarify and refine the policies and procedures.

Subject: Approve of Longmeadow Playground Equipment from Sourcewell Joint

Purchasing Agency

Background

Mundelein Park and Recreation District encourages and authorizes using several joint purchasing agencies such as Sourcewell for all types equipment. Fortunately, our playground equipment was included in the joint purchasing consortium.

Our information indicates Longmeadow Playground Equipment was installed in 1997. As part of the Capital Maintenance Schedule, Longmeadow Park Playground Equipment is scheduled for replacement in the 2022 budget as a typical life span is 20 years. As well, it is difficult finding parts and equipment which are beginning to rust and/or breaking.

Executive Director Salski retained JSD, Architects, to assist with the project as it is a significant project due to the sheer size of area, equipment and specifications. The shelter path must be moved because it does not meet ADA guidelines due to its slope. Staff identified a future improvement, relocating the basketball court as it is located in the existing parking lot. It is an expensive project so staff did not budget.

The playground equipment selection process took several months as staff worked with the Longmeadow subdivision to assess types of equipment. District received 106 responses with overwhelming support for a modern theme. Longmeadow has over 300 households so the response rate was fantastic. Additionally, residents voted on specific types of equipment that allowed for a more interactive process and choosing equipment to meet current needs while adding fun.

If equipment is approved, the District will be issuing a bid for construction/installation as soon as possible.

Analysis/Considerations

Staff reviewed a variety of vendors and NuToys Leisure Products, vendor, met the type of equipment. NuToys is a reputable company. Attached is the equipment design and breakdown of total equipment expense. The District budgeted for equipment. If the equipment is approved, a bid will be advertised and released for the installation with construction occurring April-May pending weather.

Staff did research whether Kids Around the World would remove the equipment to potentially install and use in a different country. Unfortunately, the decks are just a little too worn for the companies' specifications.

Recommendation

Staff recommends purchasing the Longmeadow Playground equipment from Sourcewell, Joint Purchasing Agency, not to exceed \$118,228.

Action and Motion Requested

Move to approve the purchase of attached playground equipment specifications for \$118,228 through the Sourcewell joint purchasing agency contract.
