Rules for Public Comment:

- A. At the start of the period for public comment ("Statement of Visitors") the board President or acting chairperson will advise the public:
 - 1. The amount of time permitted for public comment;
 - 2. That all speakers state their name and addresses before addressing the Board;
 - 3. To avoid repetitive comments, testimony and general questions; and
 - 4. To appoint only one person to speak on behalf of a group.
- B. Each person will be permitted to speak one time only, unless the President determines that allowing a speaker to address the Board again will contribute new testimony or evidence germane to an issue on the agenda for that meeting.
- C. Unless a representative spokesperson is appointed in the manner described in rule D, all comments from the public will be limited to no more than three (3) minutes per person.
- D. Groups may register a representative spokesperson by filing an appearance form no later than one (1) hour in advance of a meeting. The appearance form must designate (i) the number of people the designee represents for the purpose of making public comment; (ii) the subject matter of the public comments; and (iii) whether the individuals being represented by a group spokesperson shall be deemed to have waived their opportunity to speak independently unless the President determines that allowing such a speaker to address the Board will contribute new testimony or evidence germane to an issue on the agenda for that meeting.
 - 1. A representative spokesperson who timely files a complete appearance form to speak on a matter germane to the agenda shall be permitted to speak for three (3) minutes for each person being represented, up to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes.
 - 2. A representative spokesperson who timely files a complete appearance form to speak on a matter not germane to the agenda shall be permitted to speak for three (3) minutes for each person being represented, up to a maximum of nine (9) minutes.
- E. The Board shall not respond to questions posed during public comment. All questions shall be recorded by the Board Secretary and a response shall be presented either during the next regular Board meeting or in writing before such meeting.
- F. All comments must be civil in nature. Any person who engages in threatening, slanderous or disorderly behavior when addressing the Board shall be deemed out-of-order by the presiding officer and his or her time to address the Board at said meeting shall end.

MINUTES Mundelein Park & Recreation District Committee of the Whole August 25, 2025

The Committee of the Whole meeting of the Board of Park Commissioners of the Mundelein Park & Recreation District, Mundelein, Lake County, Illinois, was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Vice President ORTEGA directed Executive Assistant KAUFFMAN to call the roll. Present were Commissioners BURTON, McGRATH, and Vice President ORTEGA. Commissioners FRASIER and KNUDSON were absent with prior notice.

Staff present: Executive Director SALSKI, Directors BERG, FOSTER, KARL, McINERNEY, and Executive Assistant KAUFFMAN.

Visitors: None.

Executive Director SALSKI provided an update on the Walnut Ridge Development including a potential proposal for a park within the Pulte development and negotiations required by the Village of Mundelein between the Park District and Pulte concerning the Village Impact Fee Ordinance prior to annexation of the Walnut Ridge Development into the Village of Mundelein. Discussion included that Walnut Ridge is not expected to have connectivity to the Ivanhoe Village development or incorporate any off-site paths. Executive Director SALSKI explained staff estimated costs for purchase and installation of playground, garbage cans, and benches between \$131,000 to \$175,000 with an estimated annual cost to maintain the park between \$5,000 and \$7,500. He also reviewed the replacement of the playground after 15 to 25 years and the estimated property tax impact benefit annually. Executive Director SALSKI provided options for the Commissioners to consider, and discussion included that the Park District has successfully worked with Pulte in the past. It was suggested that the Park District ask Pulte for written confirmation of items agreed upon regarding the park. There was consensus among the Board members for staff to move forward working with the Village and Pulte to request construction of a park by Plute in Walnut Ridge Development with maximizing the cash donation from Pulte.

Executive Director SALSKI and Director FOSTER presented information on a proposed roof replacement at the Mundelein Heritage Museum. Background information provided by Director FOSTER included that the current roof was installed in 2006 and replacement of the roof was included in the 2025 capital budget in the amount of \$25,000. Working through the OMNIA Partners Cooperative Purchasing organization, staff identified Anthony Roofing as the best option for the museum roof replacement for \$42,850. Director FOSTER explained that the cost quoted included replacing all roof decking and he noted that if only a portion of the roof decking needs replacement the District will receive a credit of \$90 per sheet of plywood that possibly could yield a credit up to \$5,000. Board and staff discussed that the Capital Budget would be able to absorb the anticipated deficit of \$17,850.

Executive Director SALSKI presented the Administration report including a reminder to the Board of the scheduled Diamond Lake Lakefront Master Plan Open House on Wednesday, August 27th from 3 to 7:30 p.m. at the Diamond Lake Recreation Center. He also reminded the Board of the Special Meeting on Wednesday, September 3rd at 9 a.m. to tour the facilities per the Comprehensive Master Plan. Finally, Executive Director SALSKI invited the Board to the School District 120 ribbon cutting ceremony on Wednesday, September 10th.

There being no further business, Commissioner BURTON moved to adjourn at 7:29 p.m., second by
Commissioner McGRATH. A voice vote was taken with all voting yes.

Mundelein Park & Recreation District Regular Board Meeting August 25, 2025

The regular meeting of the Board of Park Commissioners of the Mundelein Park & Recreation District, Mundelein, Lake County, Illinois, was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Vice President ORTEGA and he

asked the assemblage to rise and recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

He then directed Executive Assistant KAUFFMAN to call the roll. Present were Commissioners BURTON, McGRATH, and Vice President ORTEGA. Commissioners FRASIER and KNUDSON were absent with prior notice.

Staff present: Executive Director SALSKI, Directors BERG, FOSTER, KARL, McINERNEY, and Executive Assistant KAUFFMAN.

Visitors: None.

Vice President ORTEGA requested a motion to approve the minutes of the Committee meeting on July 28, 2025, and the Regular meeting on July 28, 2025. Commissioner BURTON moved to approve the minutes of the Committee meeting on July 28, 2025, and the Regular meeting on July 28, 2025, second by Commissioner McGRATH. Vice President ORTEGA repeated the motion, asked if there were any corrections or additions. None were raised. A voice vote was taken with all voting yes.

Vice President ORTEGA read the Warrants for approval. Commissioner McGRATH moved to approve Warrants: 073125, 080125, 080325, 080425, 081125, 081525, 081725, 082525 = \$1,519,035.39, second by Commissioner BURTON. Vice President ORTEGA repeated the motion, asked if there were any questions. None were raised. A roll call vote was taken with Commissioners McGRATH, BURTON and Vice President ORTEGA voting yes.

Vice President ORTEGA requested a motion to approve the July financials. Commissioner BURTON moved to approve the July financials as presented, second by Commissioner McGRATH. Vice President ORTEGA repeated the motion, asked if there was any discussion. A roll call vote was taken with Commissioners BURTON, McGRATH, and Vice President ORTEGA voting yes.

Vice President ORTEGA requested a motion to file the July Police Report. Commissioner McGRATH moved to place the June Police Report on file, second by Commissioner BURTON. Vice President ORTEGA repeated the motion and asked if there were any questions. A voice vote was taken with all voting yes.

Vice President ORTEGA reviewed the correspondence including a news article from the Lake County News-Sun titled *Two New Inclusive Playgrounds Open to Kids and Families in Lake County This Summer* and a news article from the Daily Herald titled *Draft Master Plan Released for Diamond Lake Recreation Center, Beach and Boat Launch.* Executive Director SALSKI said the local Channel 32 Fox News also included information on the Draft Master Plan for Diamond Lake.

Vice President ORTEGA announced the consideration of Old Business. There was no additional discussion.

Vice President ORTEGA opened discussion on New Business. He requested a motion to approve Mundelein Heritage Museum Roof Replacement by Anthony Roofing through OMNIA Partners Cooperative Purchasing. Commissioner BURTON moved to approve Mundelein Heritage Museum Roof Replacement in the amount of \$42,850 with an additional 15% contingency amount of \$6,400 and to authorize the Executive Director, on behalf of the Park District, to enter into an agreement with Anthony Roofing through OMNIA Partners, second by Commissioner McGRATH. A roll call vote was taken with Commissioners BURTON, McGRATH, and Vice President ORTEGA voting yes.

Vice President ORTEGA asked if there was any Board Business. Commissioner McGRATH reported that the Mundelein Park Foundation Board met earlier that day to plan the October 9th golf outing in memory of Commissioner Dolan.

Vice President ORTEGA asked for the Staff Reports to continue from the Committee of the Whole meeting.

Director KARL presented an update on the Steeple Chase Golf Club, which included the club experienced the best July on record, surpassing 2023's record by over \$7,300. He said that the month of August was shaping up to surpass all prior months to be the best month on record. Director KARL provided an update on flooding and drainage maintenance. Vice President ORTEGA asked if the goals were set too high in the budget for the simulators, gaming, merchandise and food and beverage. Director KARL said the budget was a little too high and he said he would more aggressively budget going forward.

Director FOSTER provided an update on three major projects, including the demolition and installation of a new playground at Big & Little, a bid that was sent out for elevator maintenance and the tennis court replacement project that will commence after Labor Day.

Director BERG provided information, including the Dolan Recreation Center was professionally painted during the week of August 11th. He also noted the dance program recently hosted an open house, a car wash and McDonald's fundraiser. He also mentioned upcoming special events including the Doggy Dip on August 30th at Diamond Lake. Director BERG also provided attendance for Barefoot Bay that included a 43% increase in usage from 2024. Commissioner BURTON asked if the attendance numbers at Barefoot Bay included campers and Director BERG confirmed it did. Commissioner BURTON asked for an update on teachers for the dance program and Director BERG announced that all but three classes now have teachers. Commissioner ORTEGA asked if the incident at Barefoot Bay including alcohol consumption occurred at the Margarita-ville event and Director BERG said it did not occur at that event but instead at a regular day session.

Director McINERNEY announced that the 2026 Budget process has begun and the Board will receive the first draft of the budget at the November 10 board meeting. She also said the Fun & Wellness Committee will provide Employee Appreciation Week from September 8 through the 12th. Director McINERNEY said all cameras have now been installed at Kracklauer Park and the Mundelein Police Department has been given access to the live feed. She said the IT team is assisting employees in transitioning to One Drive and the Risk Management program will include fire extinguisher training and Mental Health First Aid in the next few months. Commissioner McGRATH asked if the number of employees has stabilized over the past years and Director McINERNEY said we have more employees year-round now.

Vice President ORTEGA announced the staff service anniversaries for August included William Sizemore, 12 years.

There being no further business, Commissioner McGRATH moved to adjourn at 7:53 p.m.,	second by

MINUTES

Mundelein Park & Recreation District Special Committee of the Whole September 3, 2025

The Special Committee of the Whole meeting of the Board of Park Commissioners of the Mundelein Park & Recreation District, Mundelein, Lake County, Illinois, was called to order at 9:00 a.m.

President KNUDSON directed Executive Assistant KAUFFMAN to call the roll. Present were Commissioners BURTON, FRASIER, McGRATH, ORTEGA and President KNUDSON.

Staff present: Executive Director SALSKI, Directors BERG, FOSTER, KARL, LAWRENCE and McINERNEY, Superintendent of Park Maintenance NEUWIRTH and Executive Assistant KAUFFMAN.

Visitors: None

Executive Director SALSKI thanked the Commissioners for attending and provided an outline of the goals for the special meeting. There was a review and discussion of the 2023 – 2028 Comprehensive Master Plan and specifically focused on the capital development projects. The Commissioners and Staff then boarded a mini-bus and toured several of the Mundelein Park & Recreation District facilities.

The tour commenced at the Steeplechase Golf Club and included onsite viewing of the bunkers, the pumphouse and the clubhouse. Director KARL was joined by Golf Course Superintendent KIVISTO and Head Golf Professional SWEENO and Director KARL described the maintenance issues and planned improvements.

The group then toured a potential site for acquisition in future years with staff suggesting developing a first right of refusal with the landowner. The group toured the central maintenance building at the Mundelein Community Center and Director FOSTER shared needed improvements including that the steel roof coating needs replacement at three outlying maintenance buildings. He told Commissioners that vehicles remain outside year-round as there is not enough garage space indoors for storing equipment and trucks. There was discussion about future rental of vacant commercial space to store equipment as an option to the need for more space.

Director BERG provided background information on record setting attendance at Barefoot Bay for the 2025 season. He also reminded the Commissioners that the facility is over 20 years old and the equipment, slides, pumps, sound system and buildings and equipment are aging and in need of pre-emptive maintenance and replacement. Staff and Commissioners toured the aquatic facilities and Superintendent of Recreation Facilities KOPP and Aquatics Manager DUFFY answered questions and provided details about the operating systems. The group then toured the Splash Pad site and discussed maintenance and operational challenges for the aging equipment as well as a long-term expansion option.

The tour included stops at the Dolan Recreation Center for discussion on a possible addition in the future and a discussion of dredging at Diamond Lake's West Channel. Staff recommended, and a consensus among the Commissioners confirmed, only moving forward with the West Channel dredging project if there is a three-way partnership between homeowners, West Shore Association and the District and including homeowners' replacement of their seawalls.

The tour concluded at the Diamond Lake Recreation Center with a review of the proposed plan for a renovated lakefront with programing opportunities and rental potential of the site. Executive Director SALSKI and Director BERG presented an operational plan with pricing structure tiers, a net operating summary and an implementation timeline.

Commissioners and staff engaged in conversation regarding phase one improvements at Steeple Chase Golf Club and Diamond Lake. There was discussion of funding of projects. It was agreed that conversation would continue at subsequent meetings in September and prior to finalizing the 2026 operating budget for the Park District.

There being no further business, Commissioner McGRATH moved to adjourn at 12:39 p.m., s	second by
Commissioner BURTON. A voice vote was taken with all voting yes.

Background

As the planning portion of the Diamond Lake Lakefront Master Plan ends, the District is focused on securing funding sources for the implementation of the project. Staff view the project as well-suited for an OSLAD Grant. Staff have utilized community feedback through an Open House, focus groups with stakeholders, and community surveys. \$35 million is available for agencies and it will be a competitive process.

Analysis/Considerations

The OSLAD submittal deadline is September 30, 2025. It is important to demonstrate to the Illinois Department of Natural Resources that the Mundelein Park & Recreation District Board of Commissioners understand and approve of the project commitment. A resolution is included as part of the board packet.

The District's application is requesting \$1.6 million with the application but IDNR only matches \$600,000. The District would be able to use other grants toward the matching or additional funds requested. The Special Recreation Funds may be utilized for key areas within the project.

The Mundelein Park & Recreation District (sponsor) hereby certifies and acknowledges that it has the sufficient funds necessary (includes cash and value of donated land) to complete the pending OLAD project within the timeframes specified herein for the project execution, and that failure to adhere to the specified project timeframe or failure to proceed with the project because of insufficient funds or change in local recreation priorities is sufficient cause for project grant termination which will also result in the ineligibility of the local project sponsor for subsequent Illinois IDNR outdoor recreation grant assistance consideration in the next two (2) consecutive grant cycles following project termination.

Acquisition and Development Projects

It is understood that the project must be completed within the timeframe established. The OSLAD timeframe is two years as is specified within the project agreement. The Billing Certificate Statement must be submitted within 45 days of the grant expiration date and the last reimbursement request must be submitted within one year of the grant expiration date. Failure to do so will result in the Project Sponsor forfeiting all project reimbursements and relieves IDNR from further payment obligations on the grant.

The Mundelein Park & Recreation District (Sponsor) further acknowledges and certifies that it will comply with all terms, conditions and regulations of 1) the Open Space Lands Acquisition and Development (OSLAD) program (17 IL Adm. Code 3025); 2)the Illinois Grant Funds Recovery Act (30 ILCS 705); 3) the federal Uniform Relocation Assistance & Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970 (P.L. 91-646) and/or the Illinois Displaced Persons Relocation Act (310 ILCS 40 et.seq.), as applicable; 4) the Illinois Human Rights Act(775 ILCS 5/1-101 et.seq.); 5)Title IV of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, (P.L. 83-352); 6) the Age Discrimination Act of 1975 (P.L. 94-135); 7) the Civil rights Restoration Act of 1964, (P.L. 100-259); and 8) the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (PL 101-336); and will maintain the project area in an attractive and safe condition, keep the facilities open to the general public during reasonable hours consistent with the type of facility, cease any farming operations, and obtain from the Illinois DNR written approval for any change or conversation of approved outdoor recreation use of the project site prior to initiating such change or conversion, and for property acquired with OSLAD assistance, agree to place a covenant restriction on the project property deed at the time of recording that stipulates the property must be used, in perpetuity, for public outdoor recreation purposes in accordance with the OSLAD programs and cannot be sold or exchanged, in whole or part, to another party without approval from the Illinois DNR, and that development at the site will commence within 3 years.

Subject: Approve of revised Rt. 60/83 drainage plan to the Diamond Lake Sports Complex

Slough, allowing a Permanent Easement for Illinois Department and Transportation (IDOT) and Mundelein Park & Recreation District providing a permanent easement

land donation

Background

The District and Fremont Township Highway Commissioner Department have been working with the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) since 2024 regarding specific property aligned with the Rt. 60/83 improvements. On August 12, 2024, Committee of the Whole Meeting, Executive Director Salski shared an alternate proposal/plan to redirect water to the Diamond Lake Sports Complex Slough avoiding significant runoff in Diamond Lake. The following benefits were presented:

- 1. The slough has the capacity to store a significant amount of water which will reduce flooding impacts on homes along Diamond Lake (mainly Willow Ave).
- 2. Directing the water to the slough will allow time and vegetation to filter out nutrients, sediment, and chlorides before flowing into the lake.
- 3. It reduces the number of detention ponds that IDOT will need to maintain.
- 4. It reduces the impact on private properties including erosion, potential flooding during heavy downpours, and property loss.

Analysis/Considerations

On August 29, Highway Township Supervisor Alicia Dodd, Gewalt Hamilton Associates and Executive Director Salski met with IDOT representatives to discuss a proposal outlined as described above. IDOT representatives were extremely supportive of the ideas and IDOT is willing to absorb the costs associated with redirecting the water. Questions and answers were shared which are listed below:

- 1. Question: The creek at Basin 12 is currently fed from a pipe under gas station. Will that remain unchanged, or will it be connected to basin?

 Answer: The existing pipe discharging to the creek off the gas station property will remain; however, the amount of flow to that pipe will be greatly reduced. Any runoff originating from the public right-of-way and areas upstream of the gas station will be disconnected from this pipe and routed into a new roadway drainage system, which will be connected to the basin. This runoff accounts for most of the flow to this pipe in the current condition. Any runoff originating from the gas station property that makes it to this pipe will continue to do so and flow to the creek without routing through the detention basin.
- 2. Question: Is the maintenance agreement needed from the township for Trinity Dr just for the ability to access? Or would there be maintenance requirements for the township?

 Answer: Along Trinity Drive, the pipe will be in public ROW and anything outside of public ROW, IDOT will be requiring additional ROW.
- Question: Is IDOT expecting the township or park district to fund any part of the proposed changes?
 Answer: None.

4. Question: With the revisions, what approvals are necessary for the Park District and Fremont Township Highway Department?

Answer: IDOT will need to obtain Permanent Easement (PE) to build the pipe from the new location of Basin 15 under North Ridge Court. This would allow us to be able to access and maintain this pipe in the future.

5. Question: What is necessary for the Park District Board to approve the use of Diamond Lake Slough?

Answer: IDOT would need in writing agreeing to the plan and donation with the easement.

6. Questions: Is the temporary shoring system high.

Answer: The cost will be placed on IDOT.

7. Question: The cost estimate shows the change in pipe cost by removing some pipes and adding others.

Answer: Some pipes may be able to be removed, a drainage study will be required to finalize the design for that.

IDOT is asking the District if consideration of a permanent easement land donation could be considered due to the significant enhancements and costs of the revised plan. IDOT will be revising its plans and absorbing costs to avoid drainage directly into Diamond Lake. A land donation would allow the timeline to be on schedule. IDOT is still finalizing the land donation amount, but Executive Director Salski believes it would be a small number compared to IDOT additional costs and based on other IDOT permanent easement approvals.

Gewalt Hamilton was extremely impressed with all three agencies collaborating on a win-win solution.

Recommendation

Executive Director Salski recommends the Board agree to rerouting per the original and agreed upon plan with IDOT to the slough and the District providing a land donation for the permanent easement. There will be more formal documents but IDOT requested the Executive Director authorize a few items so the process can continue to remain on schedule. Therefore, Executive Director Salski believes it is important to get formal support by the Board for the project and approve of a land donation associated with the slough only.

Action and Motion Requested

Move to approve a Permanent Easement for Illinois Department and Transportation (IDOT) and Mundelein Park & Recreation District providing a land donation specific to the Diamond Lake Sports Complex permanent easement area.
